Our Speakers

Keith M. Phillips received his D.M.D. from the University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine, a certificate in Prosthodontics with an M.S.D. from the University of Washington and is a Diplomate of The American Board of Prosthodontics. After completion of his postdoctoral training Dr. Phillips became Assistant Professor of Restorative Dentistry at the University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine as well as Chief of Restorative Dentistry at the University of Pennsylvania Medical Center. Dr. Phillips returned to the University of Washington to become the Director of the Graduate Program in Prosthodontics from 1996 to 2004. He is presently the Associate Director of Graduate Prosthodontics at the University of Washington and maintains a private practice in Tacoma, Washington with major areas of focus on periodontal Prosthodontics, Implant surgery, and implant assisted oral reconstruction.

Don Jayne graduated from the University Of Washington School Of Dentistry in 1975. After completing a residency at the Illinois Masonic Medical Center he returned to teach at the University of Washington School Of Dentistry. While there he developed and directed the Harborview Medical Center Dental and Oral Maxillofacial clinic. Dr Jayne lectures internationally on cosmetic dentistry, occlusion, and various aspects of restorative dentistry. He maintains a hands-on cosmetic and restorative study club. He is director for the AACD Summit hands on Cosmetic Continuum. Dr. Jayne is a Clinical Instructor for the Kois Teaching Center.. He currently maintains a cosmetic / restorative practice in Seattle, WA.
